Additional information required for preliminary documentation. Residential development, 80a and 80b Oakwood Road, Albanvale, Victoria

I am writing to you in relation to your proposal to undertake the residential development of 80a and 80b Oakwood Road, Albanvale, Victoria.

On 21 March, it was determined that the proposed action is a controlled action requiring assessment and a decision about whether approval for it should be given under the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act). In addition, it was decided that in accordance with section 87 of the EPBC Act, the proposed action would be assessed by preliminary documentation.
